### ADMISSION POLICY AND PROCEDURES K5 – 12TH GRADE

A student may be admitted to Grace Baptist Christian School only after established requirements and conditions have been fulfilled. A student or family who does not cooperate or agree with the purpose and program of the school will not be admitted or allowed to remain in the school. GBCS requires that all students beginning Kindergarten be five (5) years old on or before September 1<sup>st</sup>. Grace Baptist Christian School is not equipped to accept students with learning disabilities and/or behavior disorders.

1. **Testing:** GBCS administers entrance tests to all new prospective students entering K5 through Twelfth Grade. A \$50.00 testing fee is due at the time of testing for all 1<sup>st</sup> through Twelfth Grade students. Evaluation of the test results will be communicated to the parent(s) and/or legal guardian within two business days. At that time, parents will be informed of the results and choose whether to proceed with the application process.
2. **Application:** A completed application, all required paperwork, as well as the \$350.00 *non-refundable* application fee, **MUST** be received before an interview will be conducted. Application forms are available online from our website ([gracedu.com](http://gracedu.com)) or in the school office upon request.
3. **Interview:** A personal, confidential interview will be scheduled. Both the parent(s) (and/or legal guardian) as well as the prospective student(s) must be in attendance for this interview. Again, this interview will **NOT** be conducted until the required application process above is fulfilled.
4. **Final Acceptance:** Parent(s) and/or legal guardians will be notified as soon as possible regarding the student's acceptance. No acceptance will be finalized until all applicable documentation has been received, all necessary fees paid in full, and enrollment with FACTS Management Company is complete. Any new student granted admission is considered to be on academic probation for the first semester. Following the first semester, the student's status will be reviewed for: (1) elimination of probation; (2) extension of probation; or (3) dismissal from school.

### STUDENT DRESS CODE

Uniform clothing is required for all students in Kindergarten through Twelfth Grade. All uniform items worn by our students must be purchased through specific clothing suppliers. Pants and shorts may be purchased at any J.C. Penney store or online from the designated uniform section ONLY, as well as Buckhead Uniforms. Please refer to samples available in the school office and purchase the correct style. All other required uniform items must be purchased at Buckhead Uniforms and MUST have the correct GBCS logo. No clothing, including coats, jackets, sweaters, sweatshirts, etc., may be worn in class unless it is purchased from Buckhead Uniforms or from our school store and displays the correct GBCS logo. We also have used uniforms available for purchase.

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### Electronic Check Conversion Authorization K5 – 12th Grade

Grace Baptist Christian School has implemented a check conversion service with the following guidelines:

- Only personal, business checks, money orders, and cashier checks written against a U.S. bank account can be converted. No counter checks will be accepted for conversion.
- The paper check MICR line will be captured with a scanner/reader.
- The consumer must be notified that their paper checks will be used to make an electronic conversion. Notification can take the form of a sign posted or a written notice that the consumer is asked to sign.
- The check will be stamped "VOID" after conversion and can be picked up in the Financial Office during normal business hours. If not picked up within three business days, the check will be destroyed.

I authorize Grace Baptist Christian School to initiate an electronic debit against my bank account whenever I send a check for payment of services. The amount of the debit and bank account information will be used directly from the check. I acknowledge that the origination of ACH transactions from my account must comply with the provisioning of United States Law.
