RE-ENROLLMENT BEGINS MONDAY, JANUARY 9TH!

Yes, we are starting re-enrollment early! The emergency information that we have for your student has been sent home with their agendas or binder today (with their report card) for students in K5-8th grade. For students in 9-11th grade, the emergency info has been mailed to you. Please read through what we have on file for your child. If everything is accurate as shown, then on the reenrollment form all you will need to do is check the box. For additions or deletions of information, please use the info sheet sent to you to make all corrections, sign it, and send it back to the office so the files can be accurately updated. All re-enrollment paperwork is online. There are three pages that you will need to download, print, complete, and return to the school office.

Be sure to note that the re-enrollment fee is quite reduced as long as you take advantage of it in the month of January.

Open enrollment begins February 1st. When a new family applies, is accepted, attends for at least one month and has listed you on their application as the referral, you will receive a one-time credit of \$100.00 applied to your account. Influence your friends to join the GBCS school family and help us grow our school.
